WHO SHOULD READ THIS NOTICE

OPERS employer contacts working with new hires or employee onboarding

SITUATION OVERVIEW

Employers are often an initial point of contact for retirement questions or education from new hires or those returning to an OPERS-covered position. Because of this, you are a valuable resource to help OPERS reach its newest or returning members.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

Two new employer tools have been created to assist OPERS public employers during the onboarding process or throughout an OPERS member's career:

- Pension and Health Care Eligibility Guide created to help new or existing members understand eligibility requirements for both their pension benefit and access to health care coverage through OPERS. This item can be ordered from the opers.org Employer Forms section.
- Motion Graphic Video: New Hire created to help new members learn more about OPERS and the three retirement plans from which they can choose. This video can be downloaded and shared with new hires. This video is available to download on the opers.org Employer Tools section.
