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OPERS Selects MMRO as Disability Program Administrator

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Ohio Public Employees Retirement System has selected Managed Medical Review Organization, or MMRO, as its disability program administrator.

MMRO's duties will include conducting disability reviews and providing case management, through the administration of the OPERS Rehabilitative Services Program. That program provides for disability benefit recipients to work with MMRO's clinical nurse case managers to map out a recovery plan.

MMRO served as program administrator from 2011-2021 and resumed its role on Oct. 28, 2024.

Members of the OPERS Traditional and Combined pension plans may apply for disability benefits if they have at least five years of contributing service credit. Law enforcement members are immediately eligible for disability benefits for any on-duty illness or injury.
