## Uncontested races in 2010 OPERS Board of Trustees Election

*The remaining three groups: municipal employees, state college and university employees, and retirees will not receive a ballot.*

### Situation Overview

Three of the four seats up for election to the OPERS Board of Trustees are uncontested. Consequently, members of the following constituent groups: Municipal Employees, State College and University Employees, and Retirees will not receive a ballot for the 2010 OPERS Board of Trustees election.

### Action requested

Please inform your employees about the upcoming 2010 OPERS Board of Trustees election:

- State employees will receive a ballot for the 2010 election, however
- Municipal employees, state college and university employees, and retirees will not receive a ballot for the election.
